Celebrate and Have Fun

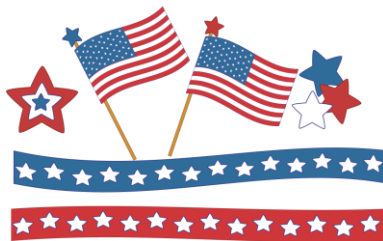
