

John Hanson



When I think of
Manitowish Waters my
mind brings up the
beautiful waters, the green
forests, big musky and John
Hanson! This might sound
like an odd mixture, but as
Town Chairman, John is
everywhere. Our Lion is
involved in almost every
event that this community
has throughout the year.

Our Lion was born and raised in Manitowish Waters and is well known by almost everyone. He is one of 4 children of Palmer and Mildred Hanson; (Elaine, Ralph and Bill). Palmer Hanson was an early leader of our business community, founding the hardware store in town on July 4, 1936. Between pumping DX gas and selling hardware, a family business was created in town.

Lion John attended Manitowish Waters grade school and then lived with relatives in Wausau to go to high school there. He would ride the Milwaukee Road train home on weekends. He graduated from Wausau High School in 1954 with an eye on college. After spending one semester at U.W, Stevens Point, a career in engineering was changed to business and our Lion spent 1½ years at U.W, Superior. Then a change of course happened when brother Bill left the hardware store and John left college to take over the business. At age 19 John was involved in running a hardware store and in 1969 another Hanson Hardware was started in Minocqua. Working in Minocqua caused John and his family to move to Arbor Vitae in 1977. John and his wife moved back to Manitowish Waters in 1995 and the Minocqua store closed in 2001.

Lion John and Mary had 5 children; Dale, Dave, Dana, Diane and Dan who passed away 21 years ago. They all reside in Wisconsin. Our Lion has 4 grandchildren; Kayala (21), Maddie (9), Danny (18) and Shelby (17).

John met Mary in 1953 on a blind date at a toboggan party behind the Bavarian Inn. They were married in 1956. They celebrated their 56th wedding anniversary this year.

John is a Charter Member of our Club. He has served 2 stints as President and time as Treasurer as well as 10 years on our Leadership Group. He has chaired our golf fund raiser for 14 years. John has received the Birch-Strum and Melvin Jones Awards as well as the 2012 Bud Hyland Award. He also noted with pride of receiving the Lioness Citizen of the Year Award.

John's long career of public service is based on his attitude that we have a great spirit of volunteerism in our town. John also take great pride in the improvement of our town.

As far as our Lions Club, John enjoys our Club's activism in community projects and is proud to be a part of our Club. We should be the ones who are proud to have Brother John Hanson as a leader of our Lions Club!
