Lion Don Barnabo was my mentor, friend and coach for 61 years. He was also a true Lion who worked behind the scenes, never looking for the spotlight – just helping our Club and Manitowish Waters.

Born in Hurley, Wisconsin, he married his high school sweetheart in 1957. They had 61 years of wedded bliss. Coach and his wife Arloa moved from Janesville after 32 years of teaching and coaching to Manitowish Waters. They took over his dad's summer home. He was honored in many ways during his career as a teacher and coach. He was voted Big 8 Coach of the Year and was inducted into our Wisconsin High School Football Coaches Hall of Fame in 1987. Once retired he enjoyed fishing, hunting and the Lions. He made jam from the fruit he picked and every spring would tap trees to make his homemade maple syrup.

As for the Lions of Manitowish Waters, he joined in the early 1990s and always remembered our motto "We Serve". Many of you remember Coach's 25 years plus of running our Lions' Bar for Pork Chop Dinners, Steak Frys and our 4th of July celebrations. Our Lion would order 10-12 different beers for the Bar and when I worked there with him I asked why so many? He said that people should be treated right and it didn't take that much more effort. He was many things in the Lions. He served on The Board of Directors, worked our weekly Bingo and helped with Roadside Clean Up. Coach also sold Lions mints back in the day. He would drive to ten or more businesses and make sure the mints were being pushed and out front on the counter.

Lion Don received almost every award the Lions could bestow; 1997 Lion of the Year and the Melvin Jones Award among many others. His quiet dedication to the Lions was a tribute to our Club and to the Man!

I hope we, as a Club, will consider renaming our Lions' Bar after this Lion who worked tirelessly for decades to foster our motto "We Serve".
