I'll just end here with a big "Thank You" to all our Lions whose volunteerism makes this club special and a valuable resource in our community. You are special!

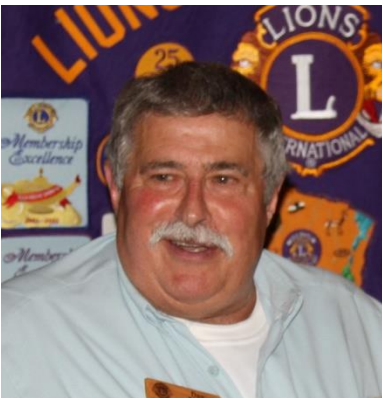

DAN MEIER

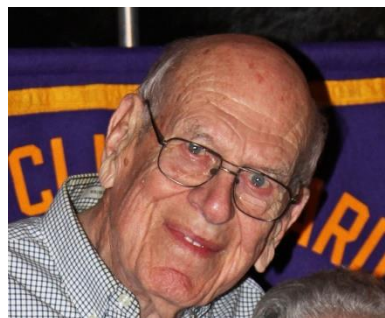
Dan Meier was honored by our Lions with **The Birch-Sturm Award**. This is given
