With just 200 tickets sold, there will be 15 cash prizes:



Joseph John Guenther


August 15, 1941 - May 29, 2023

Joseph spent numerous years traveling to Mexico with the Lions to fit glasses in some of their poorest communities. He was always behind the grill or griddle at any fundraising event. In 2007, Joseph was honored as the Lions Citizen of the Year, and Melvin Jones Fellow in 2009 for meritorious humanitarian service.

Eye Transport Service




Supporting the blind has been a long-time mission of Lions. One of the most rewarding things you can do is to volunteer to be a "transporter." Whenever a cornea becomes available anywhere north of Minocqua the Madison Eye Bank immediately responds by organizing a volunteer relay team to get the cornea to Madison as quickly as possible.

Each club in our district rotates being "on call" for a month, so each club is only the primary transport twice a year. Our club would pick up the cornea box in Minocqua and drive it to the next relay in Wausau.


Scholarship Awards
